The survey will only take five minutes to complete and measures parent satisfaction with their experience in working with education staff at their children's school and the special education services their children receive.

Would you rather complete a paper copy of the survey? All parents of Indiana students receiving special education services should receive a paper survey sometime during the second week of April 2013. Parents will receive a survey in a white business-sized envelope from their children's school, either by mail or in person. Some surveys may also be sent home with the children receiving special education services. Parents with more than one child receiving special education services should complete one survey per child. Additional paper surveys are available to parents from their children's school. If parents do not receive a survey by April 17, 2013, they should complete the survey on-line or request a paper survey by contacting the person at their children's school responsible for overseeing the special education services their children receive.

Information obtained through this statewide survey will be used to improve the quality of special education services provided to Hoosier children and their families. Results will be posted on the IDOE website later this year.
